Art Revolution Taipei 2012 (A.R.T. 2012) is the most important platform of art in Taiwan hosting leading and emerging galleries from around the world and launches this year on March 22nd. The exhibition will include cuttingedge paintings, sculptures, drawings, installations, photographs, and prints from established and emerging artists. Hundreds of artists, ranging from the established to the latest generation of emerging figures will be represented in the show's multiple sections. Art Revolution Taipei has intentionally curated the fair around the artists, rather than the gallery-oriented program as seen at other art fairs internationally. Artist in Focus Wang Liang-Yin
